EXPLORE?

Priti as the main facilitator, along with Rathi and Kavita, will facilitate the sessions where the children will explore the world of imagination, colour theory, understanding spaces, Calligraphy, Origami, patterns in nature, techniques and Art styles such as Pointillism introduced by George Seurat, Expressionism initiated by Vincent Van Gogh, Fauvism by Matisse.

Participants will also experience deep joy by exploring their emotions, thoughts and body awareness through different mediums like Painting, Crafts, Storytelling, chanting and songs. They will be encouraged to share their feelings on what they draw and how they would like to go towards perfecting their expression. This will help them blossom like a flower and also enhance their expression and communication abilities in English.
